For those of you who know me, you know that I am a huge University of Virginia fan. It's tough living in Apex North Carolina with three major universities in our backyard (Duke, NCSU, and UNC) and root for a team from another state.

I grew up in Virginia and have always been a UVA fan. For the past 10 or so years, Virginia has had a pretty solid men's basketball program led by coach Tony Bennett. In 2018 they entered the NCAA tournament as a number one seed and lost in the first round to a number 16 seed, the first time that had ever happened in the history of the NCAA tournament.

The following year, 2019, they again entered the NCAA tournament as a number one seed and proceeded to win the tournament for their first ever NCAA basketball championship. This past year, after losing several key players to graduation, Virginia experienced what sports teams call a rebuilding year and they missed the NCAA tournament for the first time in seven years. A rebuilding year is when a sports organization attempts to rebuild their program with new recruits and find a winning combination.

As I think about Salem Baptist Church in 2022, I cannot help but think we have just come through a rebuilding year. The pandemic and staff changes caused some major disruptions at Salem but things are getting back to "normal" with new staff in place and a full schedule of ministry and activities. We can take heart knowing that we are in a better position now to fulfill our mission to glorify God, make disciples who pursue Jesus, and share His Story. I believe great things are in store for Salem as we look to the future with hope and purpose as we build upon the foundation of the past and the good news and saving grace of Jesus Christ.
